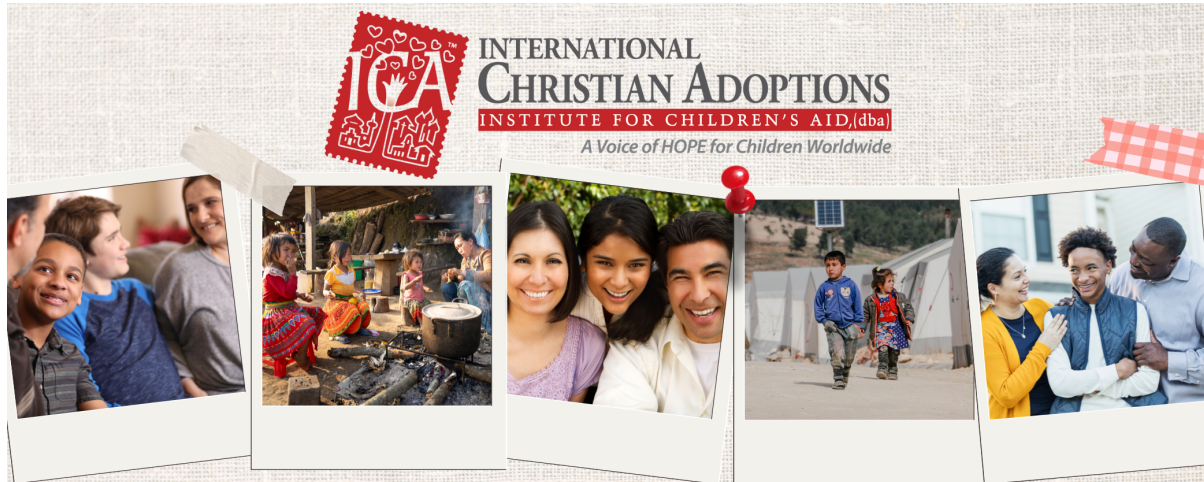

HOST HOMES NEEDED!

Over 2,000 children and youth arrive as refugees in our country annually. These children and youth have been displaced in the current migrant crisis, and many of them need a safe and stable place to call home until they are able to be reunited with family.

Special Homes, or **Host Homes**, provide a safe and stable place to call home, guidance and help teach life skills necessary for successful independence, like cooking, budgeting, and maintaining a household,
