## May is Foster Care Awareness Month!

The <u>Children's Bureau's National Foster Care Month</u> campaign recognizes the important role that people from all parts of child welfare play in supporting children, youth, and families. This year's theme highlights the need to create a child welfare system that authentically engages and supports young people who are preparing to leave foster care.

At ICA, we are joining in that campaign and adding to it the importance of coming alongside our Foster Families and supporting them as well. Whether it's by providing a meal, assisting with daily chores at their home, and many other

ways, our Foster Families also need our help and care.

### **Some Quick Stats**

There are over **365,000** children and youth in foster care.

Approximately **18,500** youth are emancipated from foster care without a permanent family.

In 2021, **77 percent** of eligible youth in foster care, ages **14–21 years old**, left care without receiving the federally funded services necessary to prepare them for adulthood and independent living.


