- The goal of Foster Care is reunification!
- Foster Care is a temporary arrangement where a child is placed with a foster family while the birth parents are provided the opportunity to address issues and to increase their capacity to provide a safe and healthy home for the child.
- The role of the foster parent is to provide a family-like setting that supports safety, stability and well-being of these children while also supporting their birth families.

Often, we have to replace these items. Assisting us in keeping up that inventory allows ICA to continue in its counseling approaches.
